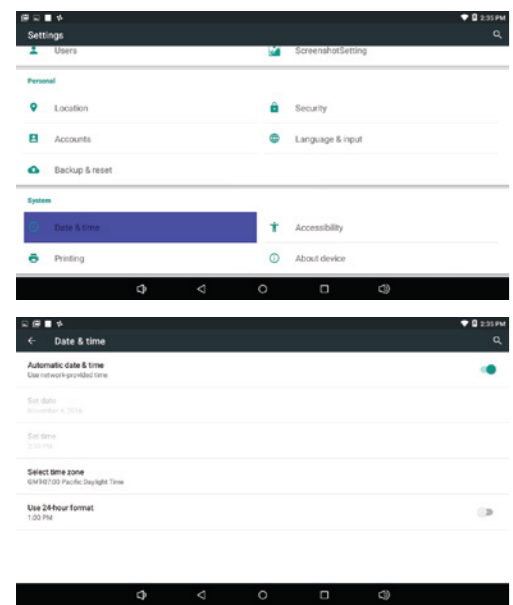

Main Menu



Volume - Back Button Home Button Task Switcher Volume +

Date and Time Settings

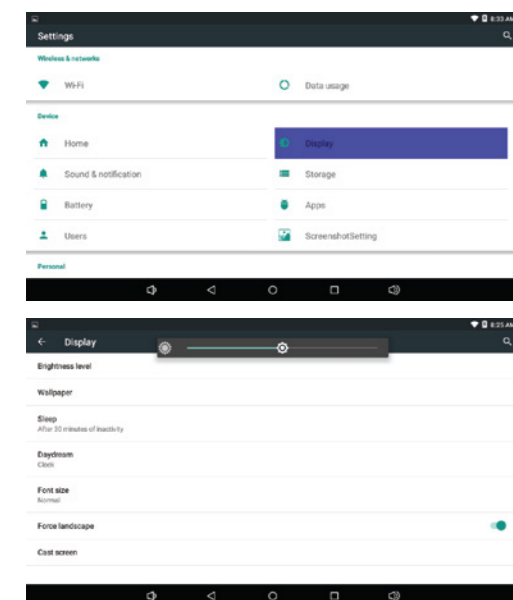


By default, AIRMM04F receives date and time information from the wireless network. When you are outside network coverage, you may want to set date and time information manually using the Date & Time settings.

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Date and Time**
2. Uncheck/disable Automatic date & time
3. Touch a setting to configure:

- **Set date:** Enter the current date
- **Set time:** Enter the current time
- **Select time zone:** Choose your local time zone
- **Use 24-hour format:** Set the format for time displays
- **Select date format:** Set the format for date displays

Display Settings



Brightness

Set the default screen brightness:

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Display > Brightness level**
2. Touch and drag the slider to adjust and set the brightness

Sleep

Set the length of delay between the last key press, screen touch or the automatic screen time out (dim and lock):

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Display > Sleep**
2. Select the desired setting

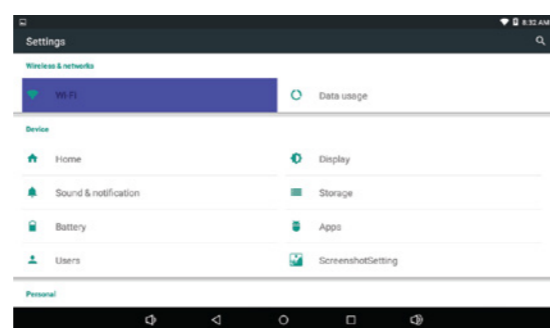

Network Settings



AIRMM04F supports Wi-Fi b/g/n. Use Wi-Fi settings to manage your device's Wi-Fi connections.

Turning Wi-Fi On or Off

Turn your device's Wi-Fi service on or off. When you turn Wi-Fi service on, AIRMM04F automatically searches for available in range Wireless Access Points (WAPs).

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Wi-Fi**
2. Touch the button to turn Wi-Fi On or Off.

Sound Settings

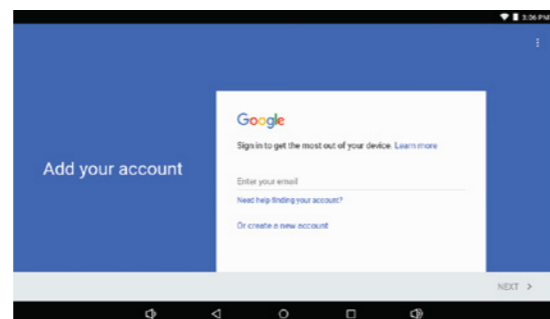
Set the volume level for all types of sounds.

Note: You can only set volume when Silent Mode is disabled.

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Sound and Notification**
2. Touch and drag the sliders to set the volume for:
 - Music, video, games, and other media: Sounds for media and so on
 - 3. Touch OK to save your setting

Tip: You can also set System volume from the Home screen by pressing the Volume Keys or the buttons on top of the unit

How To Download Apps

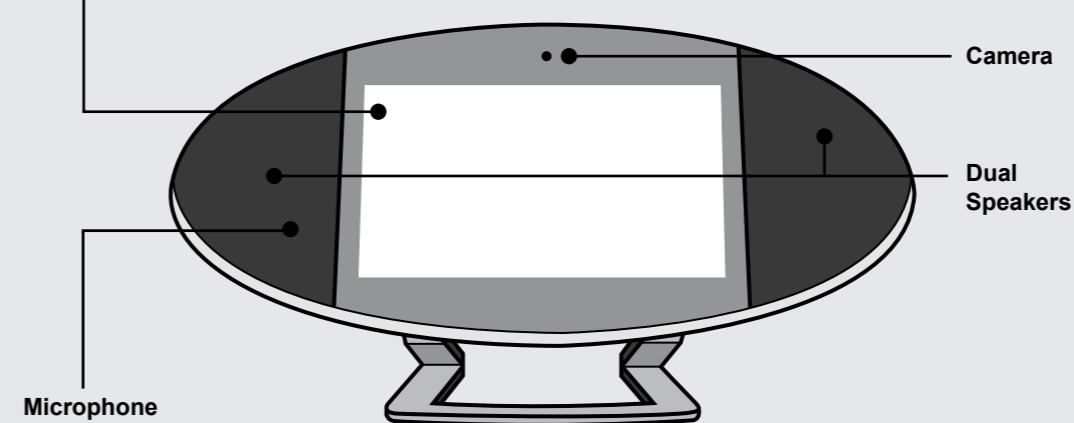


Download app from Play Store:

Network Settings

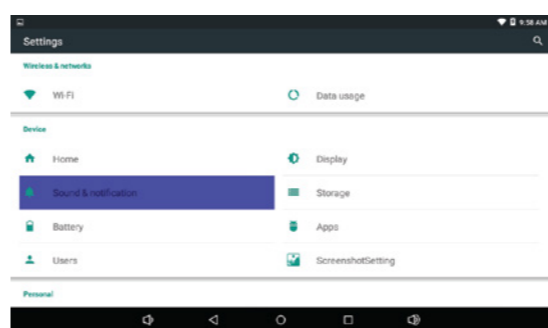


Scan

AIRMM04F scans for available Wi-Fi networks and displays the names of those it finds. Secured networks are indicated with a Lock icon. If AIRMM04F finds a network that you connected to previously, it connects to it. If not:

1. Touch the Network you want to connect to
2. Use the keyboard to enter Password
3. Touch Connect

Sound Settings



Notification Ringtone

Select a default ringtone for message, alarm and other notifications.

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Sound and Notification**
2. Touch a ringtone to hear a sample and select it
3. Touch OK to save the setting

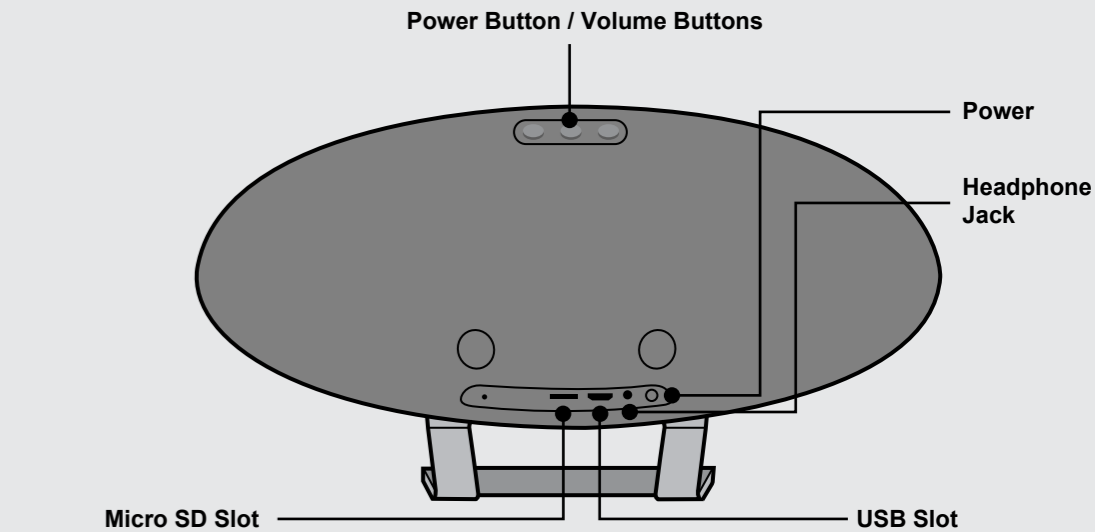
Main Menu Icon / Shortcut Settings



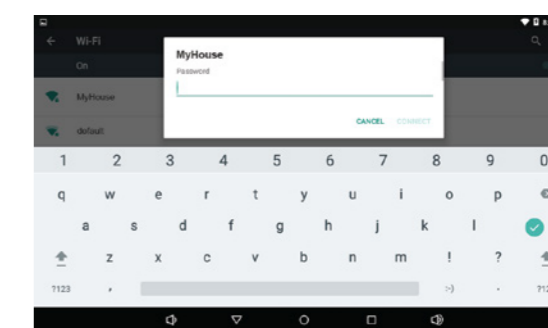
To customize the main screen app tile / shortcut:

1. Touch and hold the tile you want to change
2. Available apps will be display on the screen
3. Select the app that you want on the main screen
4. AIRMM04F will return to the main menu with the selected app as a new tile

Add Wi-Fi Network

To open a dialog where you can add a Wi-Fi network by entering its Network SSID (the name it broadcasts), security type and other properties:

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Wi-Fi**
2. Touch "+", then touch "Add Network"
3. Use keyboard to enter Network SSID
4. Touch the Security field and then touch a security type
5. Use the keyboard to enter Password
6. Touch Save

Sound Settings



Audible Selection

When enabled, tones play when you touch screen items.

1. From Home screen, touch: **Settings > Sound Notification > Other Sounds**
2. Touch Sounds to enable or disable sound tones.
